## 2018 COURSE DESCRIPTIONS & SCHEDULE

### FUNDAMENTALS OF INTERIOR DESIGN

#### 12 WEEK DAY PROGRAM

**Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays / 9:00AM - 4:30PM / \$6,995**

**Winter: January 2 - March 22**

**Spring: April 3 - June 21**

**Fall: September 11 - December 6 (no class week of Nov. 19)**

#### 24 WEEK EXECUTIVE PROGRAM

**Saturdays, 9:00AM - 5:30PM**

**Spring/Summer: April 7 - September 29 (no class May 26, Sept. 1)**

**Fall/Winter: October 6 - April 13 (no class Nov. 24, Dec. 22, 29 or Feb. 16)**

The Fundamentals of Interior Design Certification program provides students with the knowledge necessary to work as an independent Interior Designer or work within the Interior Design industry. Students learn about elements and principles of design, furniture history, floor planning, elevations, design styles, sustainable design, custom furnishings, selecting fabrics and materials, color schemes, window coverings, artwork, and more! They also learn about professional practices including business formations, communication styles and how to develop a business and marketing plan that will allow them to succeed in the field of Interior Design. The course ends with a client project and final exam.

### ADOBE INDESIGN & PHOTOSHOP

**Fridays, 8:00AM -10:00AM / \$495**

**Winter: January 5 - February 9**

**Spring: April 6 - May 11**

**Fall: September 14 - October 19**

This 6-week course will provide students with the basic Photoshop and Illustrator skills that can be used to create professional visual presentations. Students will learn how to modify and transform images by changing the color, lighting, and size of photos that can be used to build their portfolio. They will create detailed presentation boards with photos of rooms, floor plans and examples of materials to help them professionally convey their design ideas to clients.

## INTRODUCTION TO AUTOCAD & SKETCHUP

**Mondays, 8:00AM - 10:00AM / \$495**

**Winter: January 8 - February 12**

**Spring: April 9 - May 14**

**Fall: September 10 - October 15**

This 6-week Intro to AutoCAD & SketchUp course orients the student to the fundamentals and use of CAD programs in the field of Interior Design. By the completion of the course, the student should have a working knowledge of creating floor plans, elevations, and sheet layouts in AutoCAD, and a basic understanding of 3D modeling Sketchup. This class is strongly recommended for any Interior Design career.

## ADVANCED AUTOCAD

**Mondays, 9:00AM - 11:00AM / \$495**

**Winter: February 26 - March 8**

**Spring: May 21 - July 2**

**Fall: October 22 - December 3**

This 6-week course builds on the skills learned in the Intro to AutoCAD and SketchUp course. Students will learn to draw advanced floor plans, elevations, lighting plans, electrical plans, and furniture plans. By the end of the course students should be proficient using AutoCAD.

## ADVANCED SKETCHUP

**Fridays, 8:00AM - 10:00AM / \$495**

**Winter: February 16 - March 23**

**Spring: May 18 - June 22**

**Fall: October 26 - December 7**

This 6-week course is for students who successfully completed the Introduction AutoCAD & SketchUp Course and are looking to further advance their 3-D drafting skills with Sketch-Up. They will learn more advanced techniques tailored to aid in their designs and presentations.

## REVIT

**Fridays, 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM / \$495**

**Spring: April 3 - May 8**

**Fall: September 11 - October 16**

This 6-week course will cover the fundamentals of Revit in a format that promotes information retention. Students will obtain a fundamental understanding of Revit Architecture as it relates to Interior Design and the skills and technical knowledge required to model, draft, and render small projects.

## KITCHEN & BATH DESIGN

**Mondays, 10:30AM -12:30PM / \$495**

**Spring: April 9 - May 14**

**Fall: September 10 - October 15**

This 6-week introduction to Kitchen & Bath Design will provide students with an overview of the elements of kitchen and bath design through a combination of lectures and hands on activities. The lessons will cover planning and layout, cabinets, fixtures, appliances, materials and lighting. At the completion of the course students will have the basic knowledge to guide a client through the process of remodeling a kitchen or bathroom.

## COMMERCIAL DESIGN

**Mondays, 1:00PM - 5:00PM / \$1,395**

**Spring: April 2 - June 11**

**Fall: September 10 - November 12**

This 10-week course will introduce students to commercial interior design theory, concepts and application, preparing them with the knowledge and skills required to work on commercial design projects. They will learn building codes, proper space planning and materials for commercial spaces.
