Materials Provided by Heritage

Required Textbooks (Purchased by students)

Required Materials (Purchased by students)

- Laptop computer
- 3-ring binders (2) 1½ - 2" with clear pocket on face for title page (one for class notes/handouts/activities and one for the final project notebook. Other 3-ring binders or something similar will be needed for class projects (ring size to be determined by student)
- Binder divider tabs (for final project notebook)
- Metal measuring tape (minimum 25')
- Scissors to cut both paper and fabric
- Exacto knife with #11 blades
- Self-healing cutting mat 18" x 24"
- Foam core boards 24" x 36" for final project presentations. Start with 3 - you may reuse or may need to purchase more
- Scotch Mounting Squares- Permanent-1" x 1" - for mounting heavy finishes on presentation boards
- Box of push pins (small head pins) to mount products to boards for presentations
- Sketchbook/sketch pad (at least 8 ½" x 11")
- Marker with thick & thin tip combination in neutral tones and colors you will use to render interior drawings and a blending marker (Prismacolor, Copic, various brands. Shuttle Art is a more economical brand.)
- Set of colored pencils in neutral tones and colors you will use to render interior drawings (Prismacolors are great - or something with a soft lead - not Derwent)
- Artist's pocket color wheel

- Drafting supplies:
 - Graph paper 1/4" scale at least 8 1/2" x 11" size (no hole punches)
 - Vellum paper for presentation drawings (1-2 sheets). **If you are NOT taking AutoCAD, you will need more than 1-2 sheets**, but do not purchase until class begins.
 - Tracing/sketch paper at least 18" wide (1) roll
 - Architect's triangular scale/ruler (must show 1/4" and 1/2' scale)
 - Architect's drafting templates with a range of circles, appliances, and furniture in 1/4" scale.
 - Drawing pencils with various hardness levels (F, 2H, 4H, 6H, HB)
 - Archival black ink markers in various tip thicknesses (Micron, Zig or comparable, recommend a 4-5 tip size variety pack with 005, 01, 03, 05, 08)
 - Gum eraser, kneadable eraser, eraser shield
 - Triangles (30/60 angle and 45/90 angle)
 - Mechanical drafting pencil with various lead thicknesses
 - Metal straight edge with cork backing
 - Drafting dots
