Admission Requirements:

Students must be 18 years of age or older. Students should possess a high school diploma, GED or equivalent, or may be evaluated on an individual basis. Previous experience is not necessary. School staff meets with applicants to determine their career interests, skills, attitude and motivation. Heritage criteria are based upon demonstrated maturity and the desire to complete and further one's career goals in interior design. Applicants fill out an assessment form which is discussed with the director at the time of the interview. Students are accepted for enrollment during this meeting.

Tuition and Fees:

Heritage offers students tuition payment options that include: a one-time payment due prior to the start date of the Fundamentals of Interior Design Certification Program or the Interior Design Masters Certification Program; three equal monthly installment payments, with the first installment due before the start date of the certification program, the second payment due 30 days later and the final payment due 60 days after the program start date. Students enrolling in the Interior Design Master Certification Program have an additional payment option described under Schedule of Payments below. Students may select their preferred payment plan below.

The payment schedule for the 3 installments is as follows:

- Payment 1: Due 2 weeks prior to the first day of class
- Payment 2: Due 30 days after the first class
- Payment 3: Due 60 days after the first class

Additional Fees:

- Returned Check Fee: \$35.00 for any check returned unpaid
- Late Payment Fee: \$50 will be incurred on payments received more than 7 days past the due date
- Credit Card Fee: 2% of all payment made with a credit card will be charged at time of payment



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Cancellation & Refund Policy

The school's cancellation and refund policy applies to all terminations for any reason by the student or the school. Students not accepted to the school are entitled to all moneys paid. Students who cancel this contract by notifying the school within three (3) business days are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid. Students, who withdraw after three (3) business days, but before commencement of classes, are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid except the maximum cancellation charge of \$150.00. In the case of students withdrawing after commencement of any class, the school will retain a cancellation charge for each class plus a percentage of tuition and fees, which is based on the percentage of coursework provided for each class, as described in the table below. The refund is based on the official date of termination or withdrawal from that particular class.

1. The student may cancel this contract at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after signing this contract.
2. All refunds will be made within 30 days from the date of termination. The official date of termination or withdrawal of a student shall be determined in the following manner:
 - A. The date on which the school receives written notice of the student's intention to discontinue the training program; or
 - B. The date on which the student violates published school policy, which provides for termination.
 - C. Should a student fail to return from an excused leave of absence, the effective date of termination for a student on an extended leave of absence or a leave of absence is the earlier of the date the school determines the student is not returning or the day following the expected return date.
3. The student will receive a full refund of tuition and fees paid if the school discontinues a Program/Stand Alone course within a period of time a student could have reasonably completed it, except that this provision shall not apply in the event the school ceases operation.
4. The policy for granting credit for previous training shall not impact the refund policy.



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5. Postponement of a starting date, whether at the request of the school or the student, requires a written agreement signed by the student and the school. The agreement must set forth:
 - D. Whether the postponement is for the convenience of the school or the student; and,
 - E. The deadline for the new start date, beyond which the start date will not be postponed.If the course is not commenced, or the student fails to attend by the new start date set forth in the agreement, the student will be entitled to an appropriate refund of prepaid tuition and fees within 30 days of the deadline in accordance with the school's refund policy and all applicable laws and rules concerning the Private Occupational Education Act of 1981.

Notice to Student/Buyer

6. Do not sign this agreement before you have read it or if it contains any blank spaces.
7. This agreement is a legally binding instrument. The contract is binding only when the agreement is accepted, signed, and dated by the authorized official of the school or the admissions officer at the school's principal place of business. Read all pages before signing.
8. You are entitled to an exact copy of this agreement and any disclosure pages you sign.
9. This agreement and the school catalog constitute the entire agreement between the student and the school.
10. Although the school may provide placement assistance, the school does not guarantee job placement to graduates upon program completion or upon graduation.
11. The school reserves the right to reschedule the program start date when the number of students scheduled is too small.
12. The school reserves the right to terminate a students' training for unsatisfactory progress, nonpayment of tuition or failure to abide established standards of conduct.
