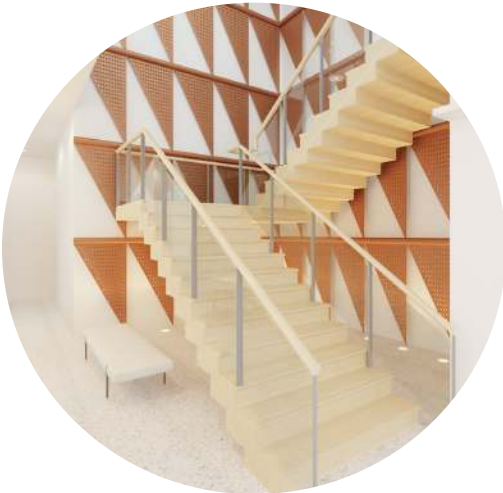

## RESTAURANT + RETAIL

All Together Now, in Brooklyn, NY, is a casual restaurant serving fresh, seasonal dishes and a boutique shop offering a curated collection of home goods, ceramics, and artwork. I created a cohesive visual brand that reflects All Together Now's core values of *creativity, sustainability, and community*. Bold colors and design elements create a buzzing, positive atmosphere that encourages customers to linger and explore. The open staircase is central to the design and features a perforated copper wall installation visible from all exterior angles.

This project included detailed research and branding, commercial codes analysis for IBC & ADA compliance, and a full set of construction drawings (Revit).

We spotlight a rotating collection of unique goods from upcoming artists and provide an event space to encourage workshops, showcases, and collaboration.

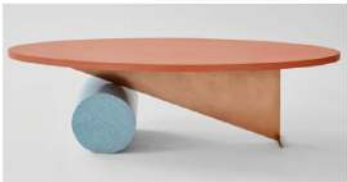


## Visual Branding & Design Elements

The color palette includes playful pastels and rich, jewel tones. Geometric architectural details make every corner of the space unique.

A suspended staircase with a two-story perforated copper wall feature is the focal point of the space. The dining area is relaxed yet modern and includes a banquette and community tables.

Upstairs, the indoor bar area is lined with glass walls and opens to a rooftop patio. Both spaces are flexible, with unique design details to enjoy as is or be customized to accommodate various events and gatherings.

# Nørrebro Kro

## HOSPITALITY

Nørrebro Kro is a boutique hotel located in Copenhagen, Denmark. The hotel offers comfort, safety, and understated luxury for travelers. The lobby was designed to be enjoyed by hotel guests as well as locals, with a cafe and ample lounge seating. Modern Scandinavian furniture and materials, such as ash hardwoods, sheepskin wool and leather, were selected to keep a neutral palette and allow the architectural elements to remain in-focus.

This was a brief collaborative project in which I contributed to the design concept and was responsible for the Sketchup perspectives and FF&E selections.

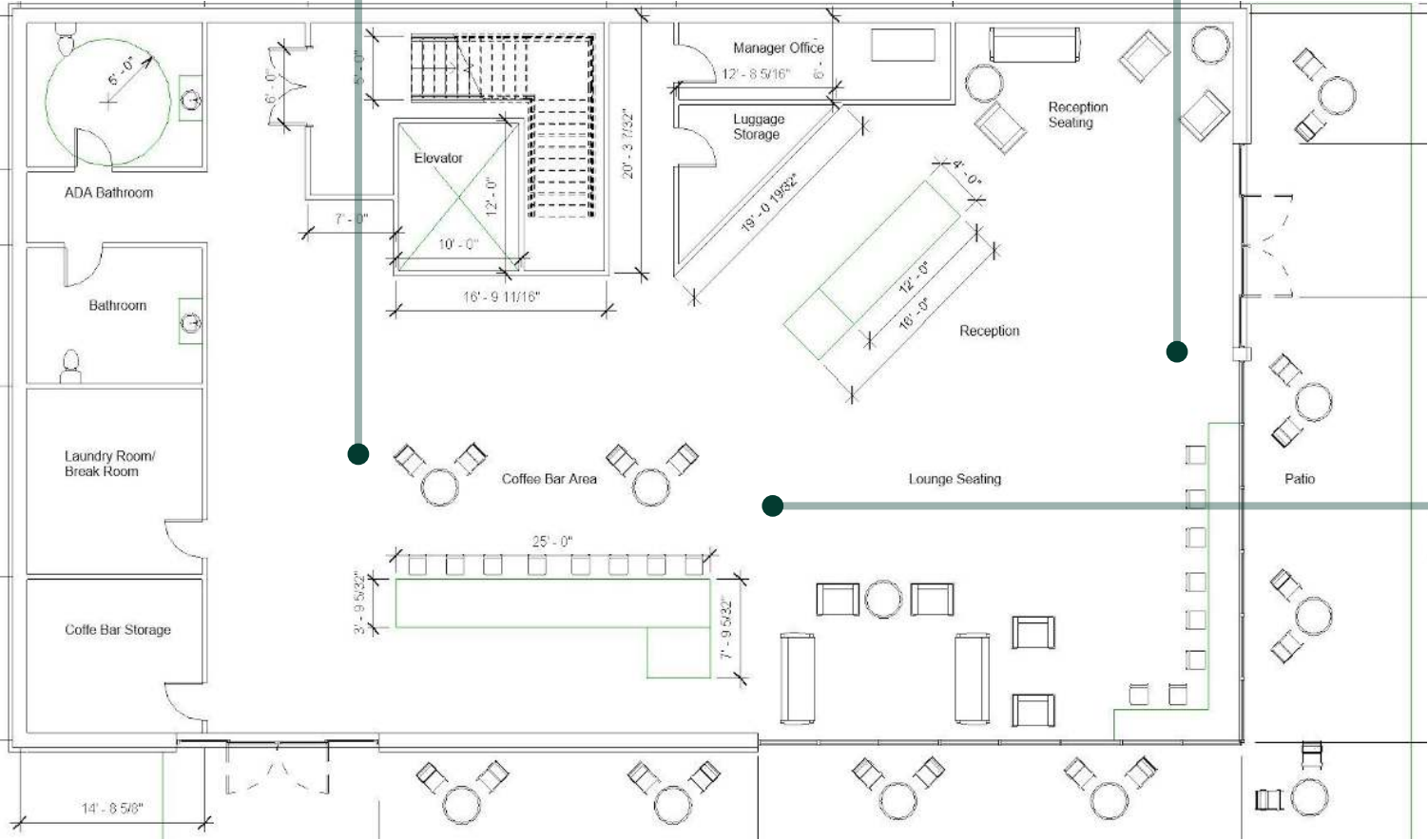

Sybil is a wine bar located in Kingston, NY, along the Hudson River. The unique story of 16-year-old Revolutionary War heroine from the area, Sybil Ludington, provided inspiration for the concept. In 1777, Sybil rode her horse 40 miles to warn her father's regiment of an impending British raid. The design aims to honor her legacy as well as the historic architecture in Kingston. Vintage cafe chairs, decorative paneling, and whitewashed brick acknowledge the historic roots of the intimate space and blend seamlessly with modern accents.

This was a brief collaborative project in which I contributed to the design concept and was responsible for the logo design and research.

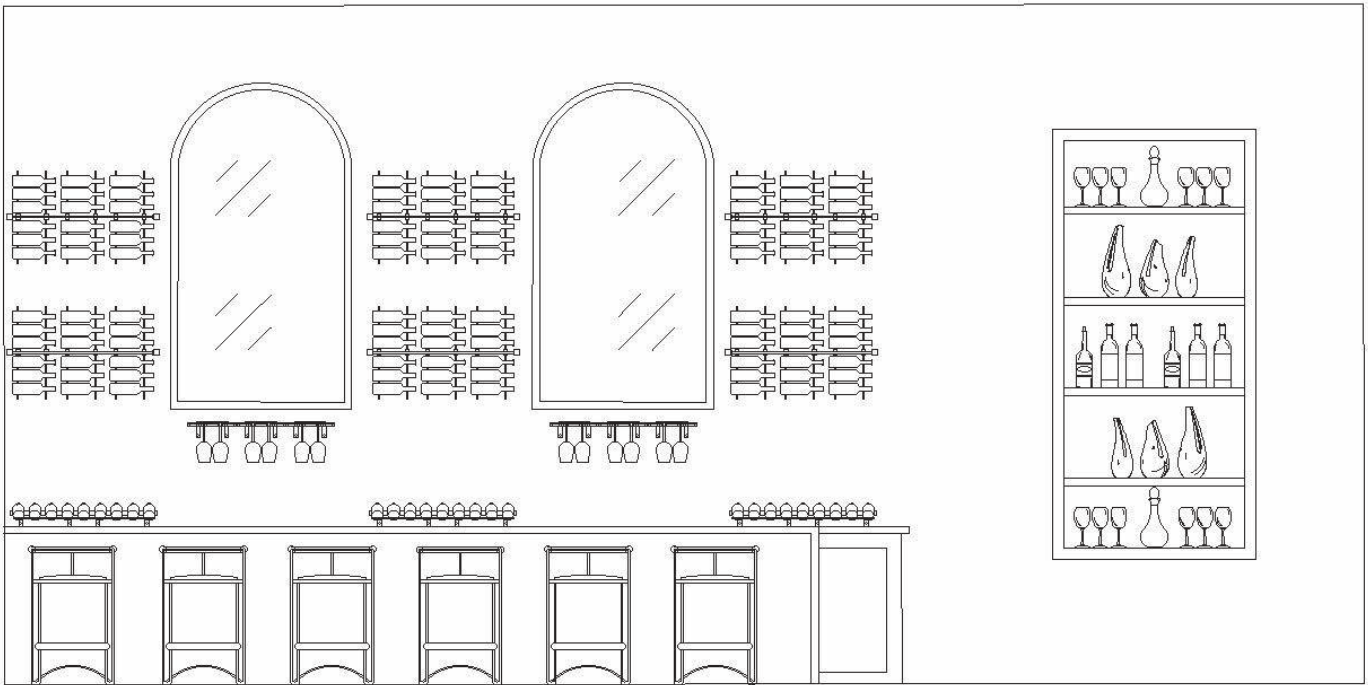


- Comprised of four separate historic buildings – created a fictional family backstory to allow each building to have a different aesthetic
- Restored each building to capture their unique architecture. The restaurant occupies a former bank lobby built in 1900
- A collection of vintage art and books are displayed along a built-in shelf, creating conversation starters
- Rich fabrics and soft light make the room glow at night, while large windows provide tons of natural light during the day

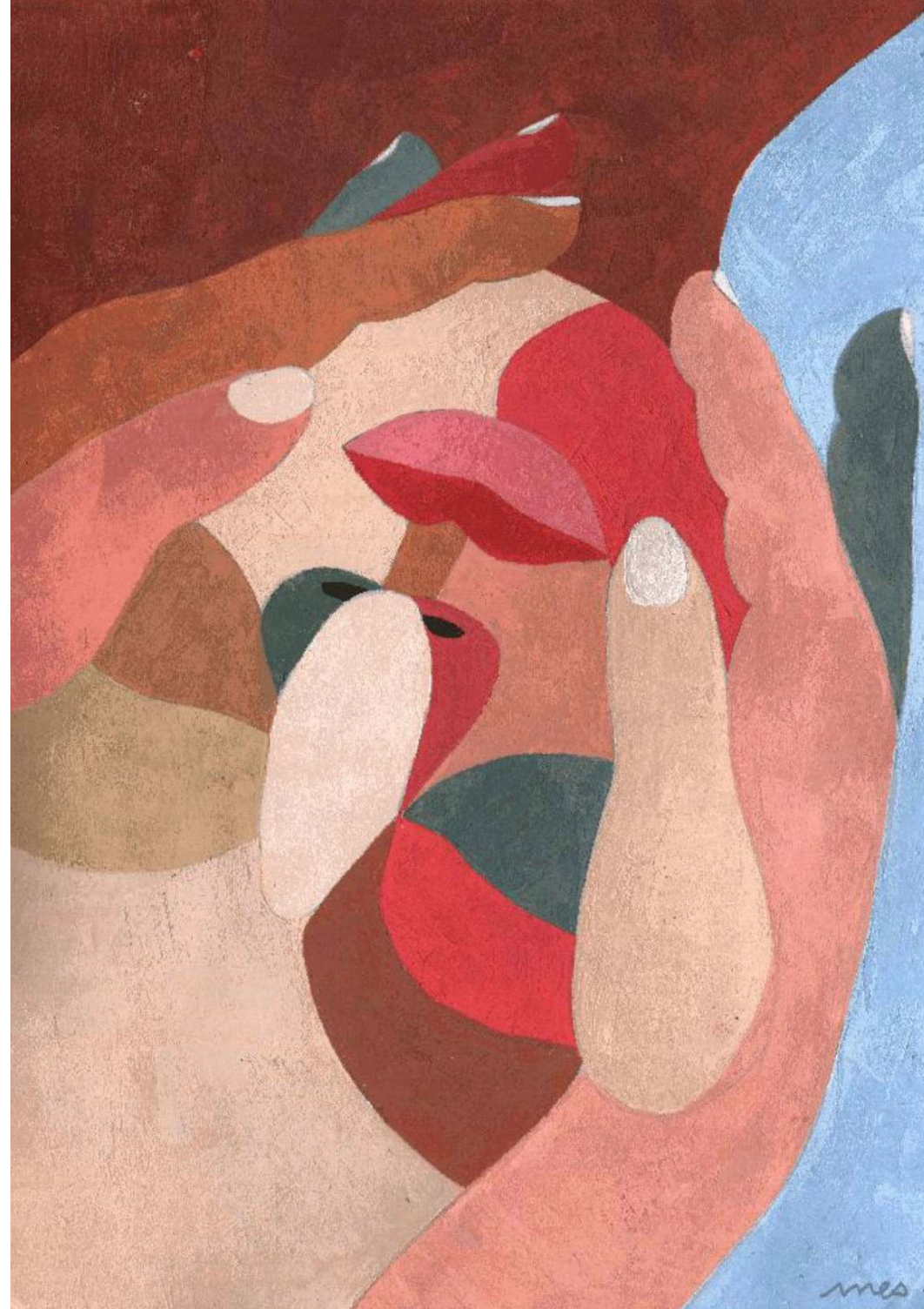
## KITCHEN + BATH

My client was a couple in their early 30's renovating the kitchen and master bathroom of their Denver home. Their favorite inspiration images included a variety of earth tones and geometric patterns. They enjoy incorporating retro and mid century elements but still want the home to feel very modern. My focus was creating functional spaces that feel extremely personalized and timeless.

For this project, we were asked to select non-interior/non-architectural images as inspiration for the concept of each space. A painting by French artist Ines Longevial (left) inspired a kitchen design rich with earth tones and texture. A Henry Matisse graphic print (right) inspired a bathroom design with bold contrast and smooth curves. Both spaces incorporate retro design elements through a modern, minimal lens.

## REYES BUNGALOW

A 900-square-foot home was fully redesigned based on my client's needs. For this project, we were paired with another classmate to design their home. My partner, Valerie Reyes, was a young, single designer. Based on her feedback and client interviews, I created a bohemian modern home that feels serene but still youthful and full of energy. White oak, layered textures, and a muted palette create warmth throughout the home.

The final project binder included a complete set of construction drawings (both hand drafted & utilizing AutoCAD) and contract administration documents.

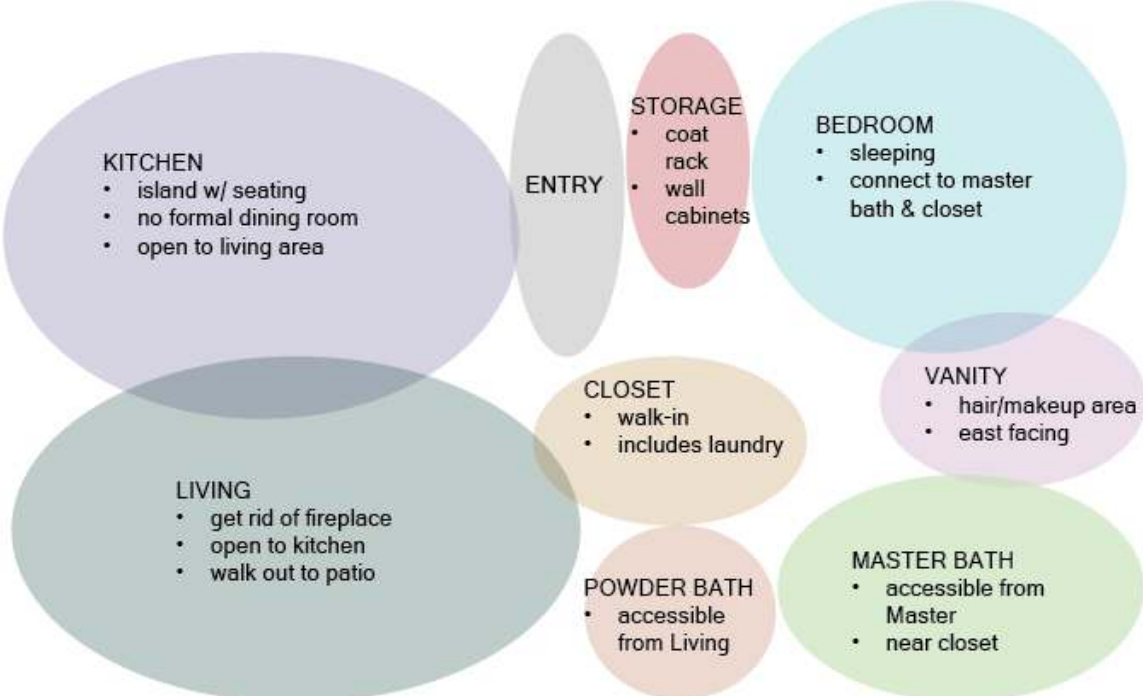

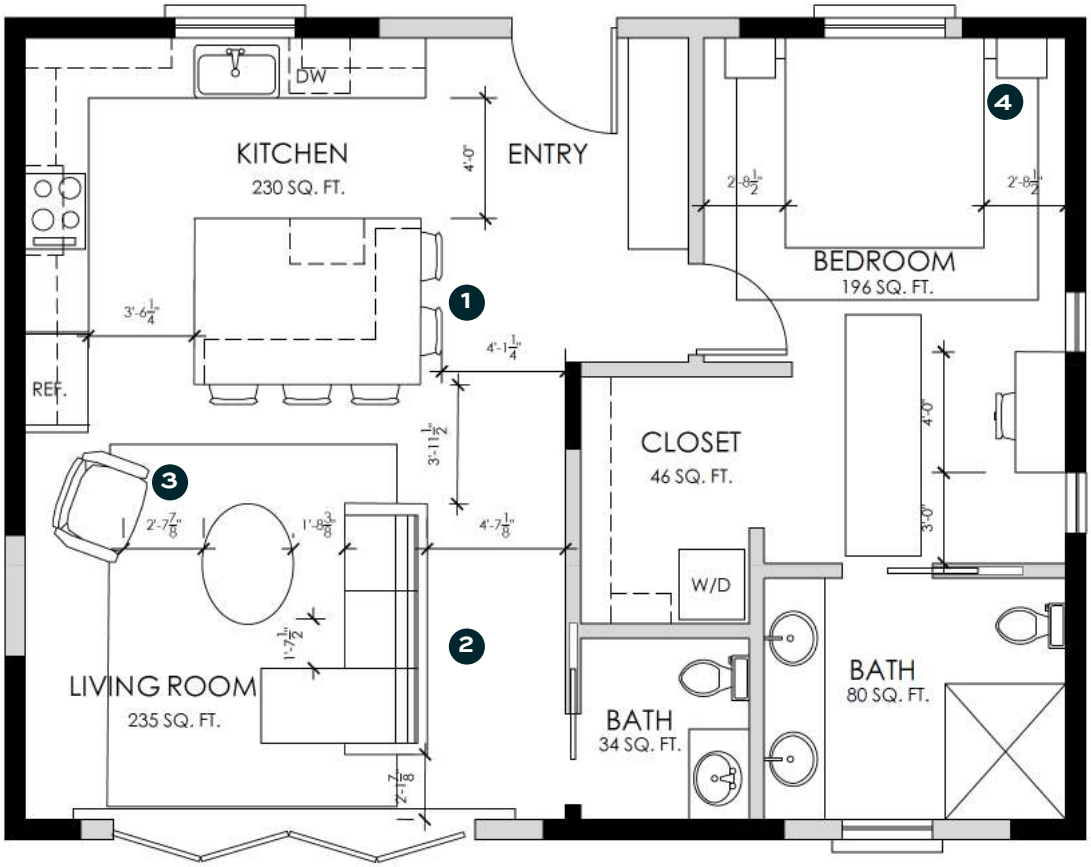

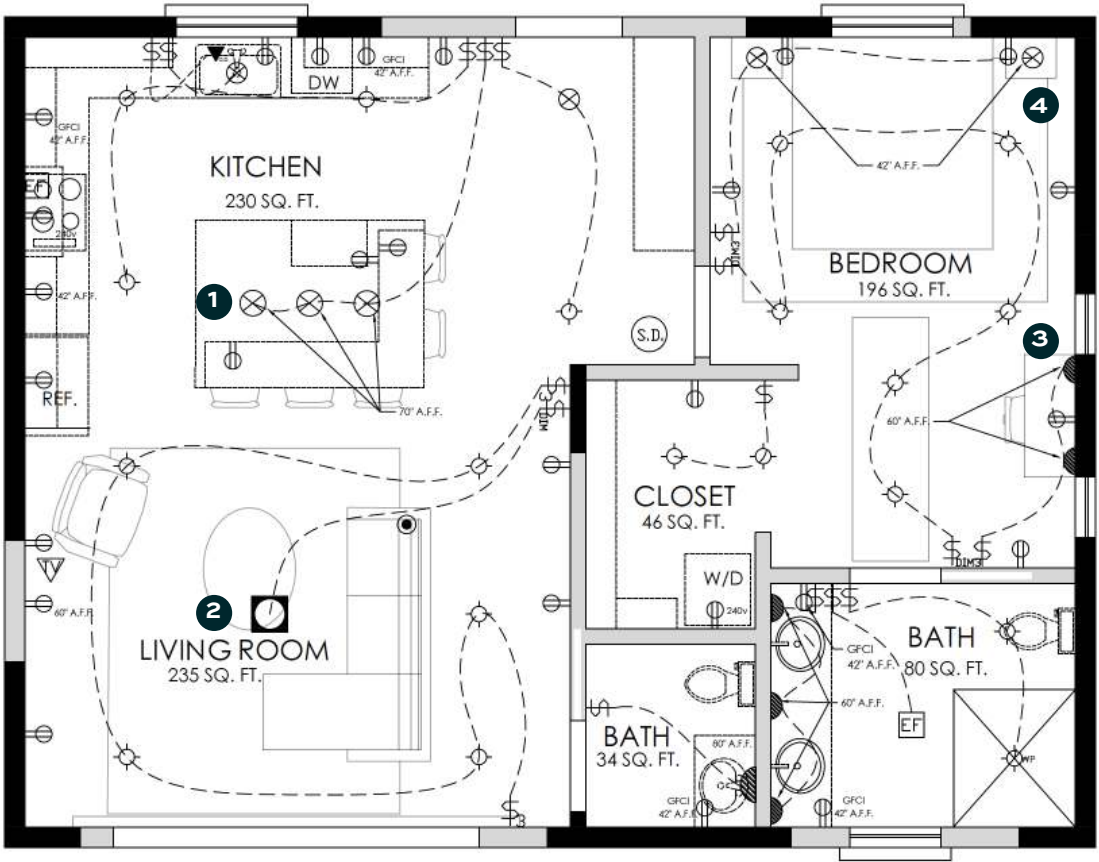
BUBBLE DIAGRAM

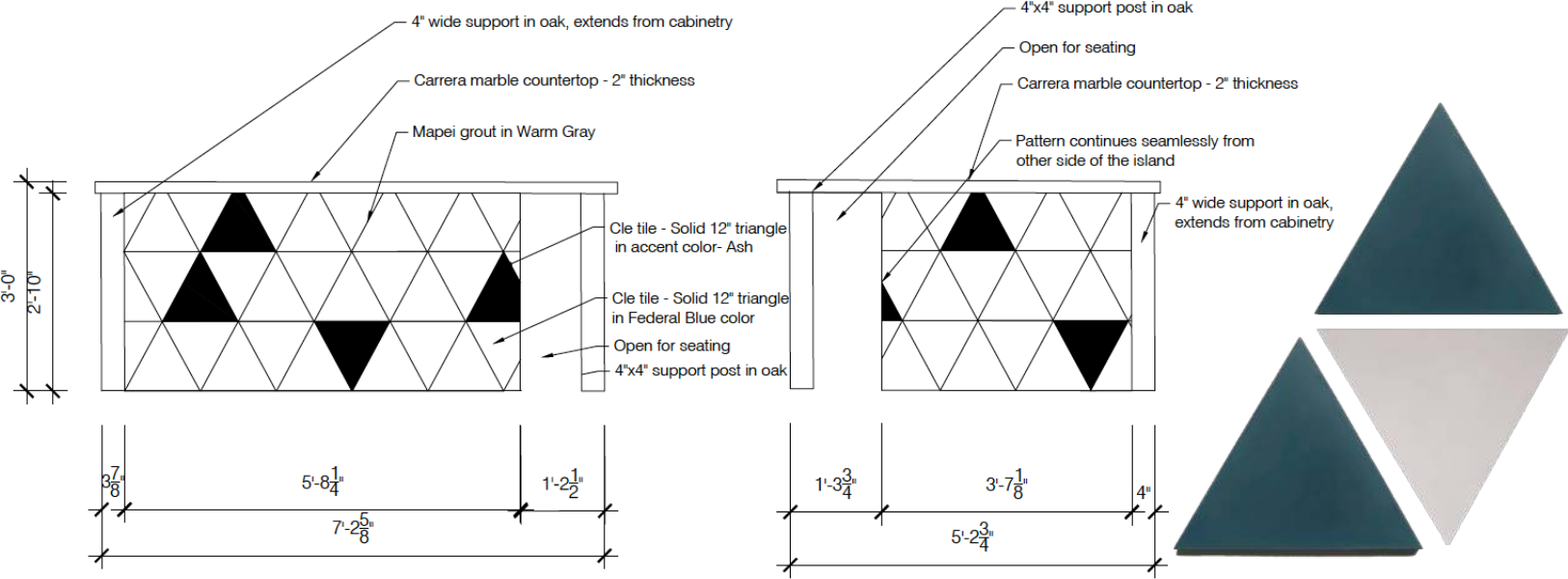
REFLECTED CEILING PLAN

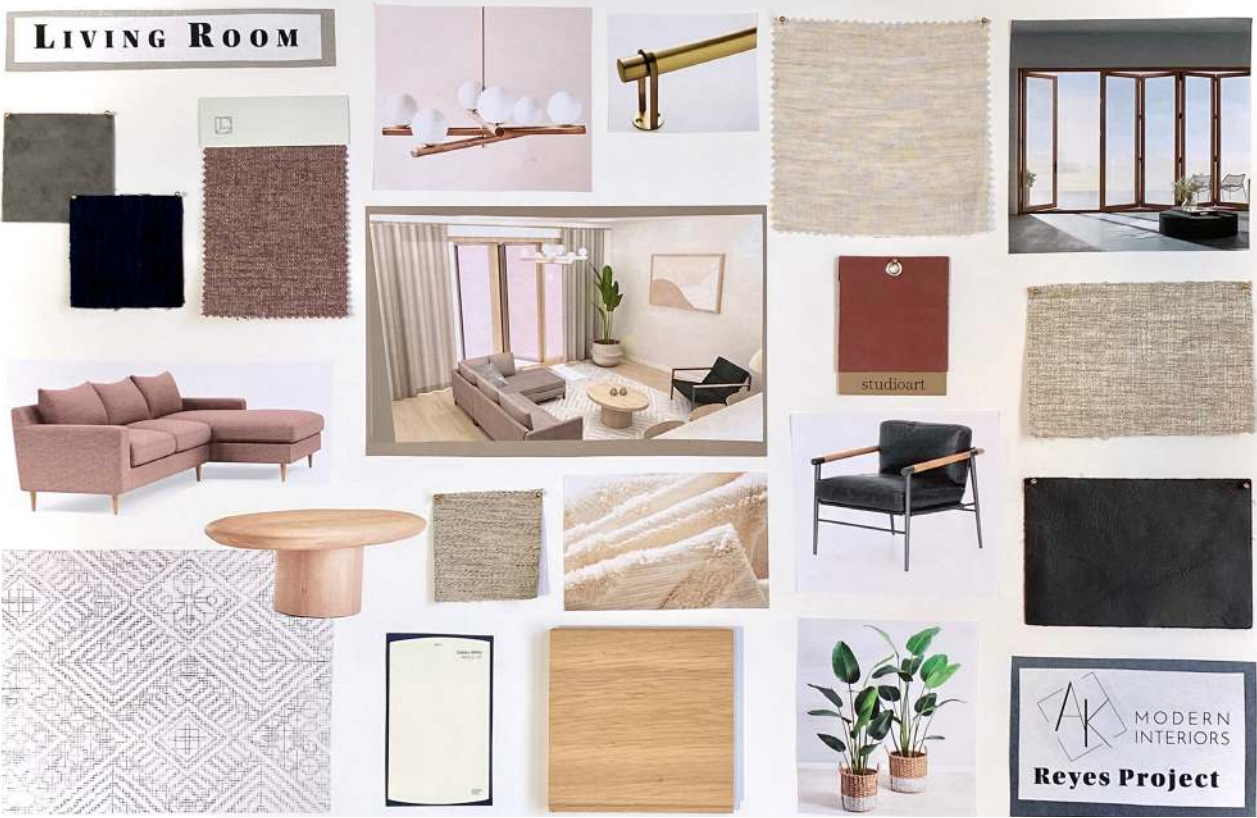
