Please bring the following supplies with you the first day of class:

- Laptop computer
- 3-ring binder (1½ - 2") with clear pocket on face for title page for class notes/handouts/activities
- Scissors to cut both paper and fabric
- Sketchbook/sketch pad (at least 8 ½" x 11")

The following supplies may be purchased prior to beginning the program except the ones that indicate to wait for instructor or project direction. You will not need any of these until the 2nd week of class.

- 3-ring binder (2 - 3", either 8.5 x 11 or 11 x 17) for the final project notebook. **Instructor specific.**
- 8.5x11 OR 11x17 clear plastic page protectors (for final project notebook). **Instructor specific.**
- Binder divider tabs (for final project notebook)
- Metal measuring tape (minimum 25')
- Drafting Board White 20 x 26. We recommend [this board](#).
- Markers with chiseled & thin tip combination in neutral tones **and** additional colors you will use to render interior drawings. In general, lighter colors are better for achieving a variety of shades that are more non-committal, darker colors cannot be layered as easily. **Please wait to purchase until you have solidified color schemes for each project.**
- Blending marker. Be sure this is the same brand as your markers, or there is a chance the blending marker may not work. If you choose another brand, make sure the product is alcohol-based.
- Set of colored pencils in neutral tones and colors you will use to render interior drawings
- You **DO NOT** need to purchase a full set of expensive colored pencils & markers!
- Artist's pocket color wheel
- **Material Board Supplies:**
 - 24" x 36" white or black foam core board. **Please wait to purchase these just prior to any given project to determine the best color.**
 - 3M double-sided foam core tape
 - Clear double-sided tape
 - OPTIONAL Material Board Supplies
 - Glue gun
 - Foam Sheet by Creatology
 - Label maker

- **Drafting supplies:**

- Graph paper 1/4" scale; 8.5" x 11" and 11" x 17" size (no hole punches)
- Vellum paper for presentation drawings – 11" x 17" size. **Please do not purchase until you receive direction from your instructor.**
- Tracing/sketch paper at least 18" wide (1) roll
- 24" T-Square
- Architect's triangular scale/ruler 18" (must show 1/4" and 1/2" scale)
- Architect's drafting templates with a range of circles, appliances, and furniture in 1/4" scale
- Drawing pencils with various hardness levels (F, 2H, 4H, 6H, HB) **OR** a mechanical drafting pencil with various lead thicknesses
- Archival black ink markers in various tip thicknesses (Micron, Zig or comparable, recommend a 4-5 tip size variety pack with 005, 01, 03, 05, 08)
- Gum eraser, kneadable eraser, eraser shield
- Triangles Large (12" - 14") one 30/60 angle & one 45/90 angle (similar to these 30/60, 45/90)
- 24" Metal straight edge with cork backing
- Drafting dots or painter's tape
